Extend Your Stay in Ohio

Near Sandusky/Huron:

- **Cedar Point Amusement Park** – The “roller coaster capital of the world.”
- **Put-in-Bay** – Reachable by ferry, the island comes alive in the summer with antique stores, bars and restaurants and a home-grown brewery and historic winery.
- **Kelley’s Island** – Less crowded than Put-in-Bay, Kelley’s is known for its restaurants, winery, Victorian homes and Glacial Grooves.
- **Marblehead Lighthouse** – The oldest, continually operational lighthouse on the Great Lakes.
- **Inland Seas Maritime Museum** – Learn about the sea-faring history of the Great Lakes at the hands-on and interactive museum.
- **Lake Erie Islands Wineries** – The temperate climate creates an ideal environment for growing wine grapes – nearby wineries include Fireland Winery, Mon Ami, Heineman’s Winery and Kelley’s Island Wine Company.
- **Seneca Caverns** – One of the largest underground caverns in Ohio.
- **Thomas Edison’s Birthplace** – Still standing in its original location, the home has been restored and converted into a museum for Edison artifacts, inventions and memorabilia.

Within a 1-hour drive:

- **Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum** – The largest single collection of rock and roll artifacts.
- **Great Lakes Science Center** – Home to the NASA Glenn Visitor Center, hundreds of hands-on exhibits and a six-story OMNIMAX theater.
- **A Christmas Story House** – Relive “A Christmas Story” at Ralphie’s actual house used in the film, completely restored to its movie splendor.
- **Cleveland Botanical Garden** – 10 acres of beautiful gardens, including an award-winning children’s garden.
- **Western Reserve Historical Society** – Special site collections include Crawford Auto-Aviation Museum, Archives/Library (a destination for genealogical research), and Outdoor Living History Museum.
- **Cleveland Metroparks Zoo and The Rainforest** – The Zoo and RainForest are home to more than 3,000 animals representing six continents.
