WHAT: Official White House Christmas Tree

Tree will be harvested from the farm of the 2011 National Christmas Tree Association Grand Champion winner of the national tree contest.

Sue and Tom Schroeder will present First Lady Michelle Obama with the Christmas Tree selected from their farm on November 25, 2011. The tree will be displayed in the White House Blue Room this holiday season.

Winners of the National Christmas Tree Association national tree contest have provided the official White House Christmas Tree since 1966.

WHEN: Thursday, November 17, 2011 - time 10:00 A.M. (central)

WHERE: Schroeder's Forevergreens (See directions below.)

## From Fox Valley and Green Bay Area-approx. 50 miles from Oshkosh:

Take US 41 S to WI 21 W at Oshkosh. (NOTE: there may be detours)

Follow WI 21 W to Wautoma-approx. 36 miles.

On the west side of Wautoma, WI 22 joins WI 21 W and makes a left turn to the South. Be sure to follow signs. At stop sign, just past Wautoma High School, continue straight on WI 22 S toward Montello.

Follow WI 22 S approx. 12 miles to the farm.

### From the Milwaukee area:

Take I-94 toward Madison.

Take I-90/I-39 North toward WI Dells/ Portage

At the I-90/I-39 split follow I-39 North toward Portage

Take I-39 North to exit 113 at Westfield.

Follow Directions from Westfield-see below.

## From the Madison area-approx. 75 miles from Madison:

Take I-90/I-39 North toward WI Dells/ Portage

At the I-90/I-39 split follow I-39 North toward Portage

Take I-39 North to exit 113 at Westfield.

Follow Directions from Westfield-see below.

# From Stevens Point/Wausau Area-approx 55 miles from Stevens Point:

Take I-39 South to exit 113 at Westfield.

Follow Directions from Westfield-see below.

## From Westfield, I-39, exit 113-approx 11.5 miles:

Turn East off of Exit 113 on County Road E

After .2 mi turn Left to stay on County Road E

After 1 mi turn Right to stay on County Road E

After 9.1 miles turn Right onto WI 22 South

Follow WI 22 S for approx. 1 mile to farm
